Description:	There is an alternate partition in use when doing "calculate -{c,D,m}". Desktop versions of CL have it as 10G in size. There is not enough much space for compiling OpenOffice in case of CLD. It needs no less than 6G but ~5,9G available only. As of it, one forced to bind <code>_/mnt/builder/var/calculate/tmp_</code> to <code>_/var/calculate/tmp_</code> by hand. <code>*/dev/sda5*</code> is usually a much bigger (mine's 200G) than <code>*/dev/sda{2,3}*</code> for desktop systems. So, why not to do all stages in <code>_/var/calculate/tmp/something_</code> instead?
