

## Calculate Linux - Bug # 646: no vnc or spice control in virt-manager

<b>Description:</b>	<p>Hi,</p> <p>I have emerged virt-manager and everything went fine.</p> <p>BUT: there is no usable vnc or spice display</p> <p>The screen is simply frozen to a former state, no keys, nothing.</p> <p>I can send keys, e.g CTRL+ALT+DEKLETE and the image restarts but then I can see GRUB booting and the screen freezes again.</p> <p>The server seems to be functional, as I can connect to the image via vncviewer. This is a workaround but not satisfying...</p> <p>Greetings</p> <p>TS</p>

I have the exact same problem, and for a long time. I do not remember from what version of Calculate it started. Previously everything worked great. However, SPICE works correctly. I connect through spicec. But you should add video QXL and display SPICE \*from scratch\*. Just delete old VNC video and display. Unfortunately it is not very convenient. :(

Note: You must remove the VNC Display and then add the Spice Display ... you can NOT change the VNC Display to a Spice Display as that does not add the extra devices necessary to use spice. (<http://wiki.centos.org/HowTos/Spice-libvirt>)
